Furthermore, we successfully implemented a new internal quality system at STU. This is an important step and a proof that our university puts special emphasis on the quality, which has been confirmed by current domestic and international rankings. Our graduates are the most preferred on the market, and STU is the only Slovak university, among the 550 evaluated world universities, in the QS Graduate Employability Rankings 2022.

In 2021, the Slovak University of Technology, together with the whole society experienced complicated and unprecedented situations. University activities were held back by various restrictions associated with the pandemic. However, thanks to the commitment of teachers, students, and other employees, we managed to handle the given tasks under difficult conditions with the support of our partners within the CEVIS project.

A decline in the number of students in our university was halted mainly due to the growing number of foreign students. In a short time, we managed to fully activate all university bodies, and the new University Management vigorously began to accelerate the processes towards a better, more efficient and more attractive STU. Modern teaching facilities, state-of-the-art laboratories, renovated dormitories, and sports grounds, which are gradually becoming a reality, will be part of a future top campus.





Online registration

For online registration you need to take the following steps:

- sign in to the portal ubytovanie. stuba.sk
- click on the Internet tab Ynet and start the pre-registration
- the server will automatically provide the needed data for our server and will automatically pre-fill them.
 These data can no longer be changed, if you find a mistake, correct it in the academic system
- check your phone number, it must be a Slovak number, send an SMS if there is an error in the number, please correct it at the ubytovanie. stuba.sk
- fill in the remaining data required for the registration
- when the pre-registration is complete, you will receive an SMS with your first password
- log in to the portal.ynet.sk with your login and password. After the first signing in, you become automatically a member of Ynet and you can use all the benefits of membership as your classmates in accordance with the association's Articles of Association, within 5 days you need to pay the registration fee and the membership fee




















Side Job

In Slovakia, students can work for a maximum of 20 hours per week on average.

Age limit

You can sign an agreement if you are under 26 years old. Work based on an already concluded agreement can be performed after reaching the specified age no later than the end of the calendar year in which you reached this age.

Erasmus+ insurance

ERAPO

Only ERAPO travel insurance offers the needed coverage for each type of mobility that meets the requirements of the ERASMUS+ programme.

FAQ

Who can use ERAPO travel isurance?

ERAPO travel insurance can be taken out by university students, secondary school students, graduates, pedagogical staff, and by teachers. That is, by everyone who is going on an ERASMUS+ stay.

How will use ERAPO travel insurance?

The travel insurance for ERASMUS+ can be used easily online via our erapo.sk website. You will receive all the necessary documents electronically by e-mail and you can transfer the payment using online banking or by sending a direct deposit to our bank account. There is no need to go anywhere, you will have it done online in a few minutes.

In which countries is ERAPO travel insurance valid?

ERAPO travel insurance is valid in those countries you select during the application process when choosing the destination (the country you are travelling to) or when selecting directly one of three insurance rates according to the following areas:

Czech Republic – the insurance is valid only in the Czech Republic

Europe – the insurance is valid in Europe + Egypt, Turkey, Tunisia, Cyprus, Algeria,

Entry of Foreigners during the Extraordinary Situation


From 6 April 2022, the Decree of the Public Health Authority of the Slovak Republic No. 28/2022 regulating the regime at the borders has been repealed. Thus, the obligation to register on eHranica, as well as the mandatory quarantine for unvaccinated persons immediately after the arrival from abroad are abolished. However, it is still recommended to be cautious, to monitor your health condition, and to contact your general practitioner or pediatrician in case of Covid-19 symptoms.

Bratislava is the capital and largest city of Slovakia.

Officially, the population of the city is about 475,000. However, it is estimated to be more than 660,000. Bratislava is in southwestern Slovakia at the foot of the Little Carpathians, occupying both banks of the River Danube and the left bank of the River Morava. Bordering Austria and Hungary, it is the only national capital that borders two sovereign states.

The city's history has been influenced by people of many nations and religions, including Austrians, Bulgarians, Croats, Czechs, Germans, Hungarians, Jews, Romani, Serbs and Slovaks. It was the coronation site, legislative center and the capital of the Kingdom of Hungary from 1536 to 1783. Altogether, eleven Hungarian kings and eight queens were crowned in St Martin's Cathedral. Most Hungarian parliament assemblies were held here from the 17th century until the Hungarian Reform Era, and the city has been home to many Hungarian, German, and Slovak historical figures.

Today Bratislava is the political, cultural and economic centre of Slovakia. It is the seat of the Slovak president, the parliament and the Slovak Executive. It has several universities, and numerous museums, theatres, galleries, and other cultural and educational institutions Many of Slovakia's large businesses and financial institutions have headquarters there.







Bratislava castle is the main castle of Bratislava. Its location provides excellent views of Bratislava, Austria and, in clear weather, parts of Hungary.



Public transport

in Bratislava

Bratislava has built an understandable public transport line system of buses, trams, and trolleys, which convey at regular intervals according to timetables. Apps with timetables are available both for Android and iOS.

Nearly all sights and main monuments in Bratislava can be reached on foot, however, when you need to get to the airport, to the bus station or to the main train station we recommend to use public transport lines or taxi.



Buving tickets

Buying tickets

30 minutes (0.90€) - transfers are allowed, on weekends the ticket is valid for 90 minutes. **60 minutes (1.20€)** - transfers are allowed, on weekends the ticket is valid for 90 minutes. **24-hours (3.50€),** 72-hours ticket (8.00€), or 168-hours (11.40€) - transfers allowed; it is a good choice for tourists to want to use the public transport more frequently. It allows you to travel as much as you need by all forms of transport.

Subscription tickets (tram tickets) - Subscription travel tickets, also known as tram tickets, are primarily intended for regular passengers. During the period of validity, the passenger can transfer and combine means of transport of all carriers in integrated transport in the territory where the ticket is valid.

Traveling in Slovakia

Getting around by train

Travelling around Slovakia by train is the best way to enjoy the natural scenery of the landscape, and maybe you can even get in contact with natives. If planned well, taking a train is the most comfortable and fastest way to get around.

The main rail artery of Slovakia is the rail route from Bratislava through Žilina and Poprad to Košice (5-6 hours, depending on a type of the train). You can take a train to most towns or interesting destinations. A very nice experience is a journey by a passenger train on one of many scenic routes through picturesque mountain landscape. Train services on most of the routes are provided by Železničná spoločnosť Slovensko. Some lines are operated by RegioJet, and Leo Express private carriers.

Free Transport discount for students

Students under 26 years and pensioners under 62 years who are citizens or permanent residents of EU member states are entitled for zero-fare transport. Železničná spoločnosť Slovensko accepts following identity documents (a photograph is necessary): ID card, passport, confirmation of enrolment for the current academic year. Online: at Slovakrail, or using cell phone at: m.slovakrail.sk or in person at almost every railway station, or from the conductor on the train (generally with a lower surcharge).



Types of trains

Eurocity (EC, IC): is a comfortable and fast solution for a journey from neighbouring countries (EC), or within Slovakia (IC). Trains stop at selected stations only. Air conditioned carriages, and restaurant car are available. In the IC trains, there is Wi-Fi connection. Fast trains and Express trains (R, Ex) provide fast and frequent connections between many Slovak towns. Passenger train (Os) connects smaller towns on shorter distances.

Deposit return system in Slovakia

The Deposit return system is a tool of extended producer responsibility that can increase the amount of collected PET bottles and cans to more than 90 %. It supports recycling and help reducing the amount of litter in nature.

How does it work?

Consumers return the drink container to the retailer, who will pay him back the deposit.

The retailer returns the collected containers to the Administrator. The Administrator pays him back the deposit together with a handling fee, in return for handling the containers.

The Administrator ensures inspection, counting, transport and processing of containers.


