

LANGUAGE CENTRE offers modules/courses for all those from abroad who are interested in:

- working, or who already work and live in Slovakia and need to communicate in their workplace;
 - learning to communicate in Slovak language;
- studying in Slovak language at a faculty of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava;
 - completing their knowledge of other technical subjects.







Module SLOVAK LANGUAGE A (MSLA)

(50 hours A1; 50 hours A2)

The graduate will acquire four language skills at the required (Basic A) level, i.e., reading comprehension, comprehensive listening, basic oral and written communication of everyday life.

Module SLOVAK LANGUAGE B (MSLB)

(120 hours B1; 120 hours B2)

The graduate will acquire four language skills at the required (Medium B) level, i.e., reading comprehension, comprehensive listening, the required oral and written communication skills. He/she can orient himself/herself in everyday situations, use common vocabulary, describe his/her activities. He/she can make small talks at unofficial and official levels.




The students who want to study in Slovak language at a selected faculty of the STU are designed:

Module INTENSIVE SLOVAK LANGUAGE (MISL)

(640 hours – winter term 320 hours; summer term 320 hours)

The graduate will acquire four skills at the required (advanced) level, i.e., reading comprehension, comprehensive listening, basic oral and written communication on everyday topics by means of teaaching materials contained in the respective lessons of textbooks, and basic terminology of technical fields of study. He/she can independently communicate, describe everyday activities, orient himself/herself in time and space, express past actions, fill-in a questionnaire, write his/her CV.





Module ENGLISH LANGUAGE A (MELA)

(40 hours A1; 40 hours A2)

The graduate will acquire necessary vocabulary, verbal skills in communicative situations in oral communication and writing in English, and will master basic technical terminology of technical fields of study.



Module SPANISH LANGUAGE A (MSLA)

(40 hours A1; 40 hours A2)

The graduate will acquire necessary vocabulary, verbal skills in communicative situations in oral communication and writing in Spanish, and will master basic technical terminology of technical fields of study.





Module BASICS OF WORK WITH PC (MBWPC)

(25 hours, teaching in Slovak/or English language)

The graduate will acquire knowledge in basics of work with PC. He/she will be prepared for pursuing the study programme in the selected faculty of the STU. He/she will adapt his professional knowledge to the conditions of practice.

Module GUIDE FOR FOREIGN APPLICANTS (MGFA)

(22 hours, in Slovak/or English language)

The graduate will acquire knowledge of the life and institutions of Slovakia and useful information that he/she will utilize during his/her stay in Slovakia. Life in Slovakia (transport, insurance, health and medical care), work (recognition of documents and qualifications), study possibilities (conditions, organization and structure of study, recognition of documents, scholarships, internships, accommodation ...), formalities (entry and residence visas), consulting (useful addresses and contacts ...).



Module MATHEMATICS (MMATH)

(52 hours, teaching in Slovak/or English language)

The graduate will be equipped with knowledge of Mathematics in theoretical and practical applications and will be prepared for pursuing the study programme in the selected faculty of the STU. He/she will adapt his professional knowledge to the conditions of practice.

Module PHYSICS (MPH)

(24 hours, teaching in Slovak/or English language)

The graduate will gain knowledge of basics of Physics in applied sciences and engineering, and will use his/her knowledge in theoretical and practical applications.





Module GEOLOGY (MGO)


(24 hours, teaching in Slovak/or English language)

The graduate will be equipped with knowledge of Geology Basics of applied sciences and engineering, and will make use of his/her knowledge in theoretical and practical applications.

Module ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING (MEE)

(24 hours, teaching in Slovak/or English language)

The graduate will be equipped with knowledge of Environmental Engineering and capable to use the achieved theoretical and practical knowledge, and prepared for pursuing the study programme in the selected faculty of the STU.





ORGANIZATION OF TEACHING

Teaching takes place in the morning or in the afternoon, a study group consists of 6 to 12 students.

Teachers are specialized in teaching Slovak as a foreign language.


METHODS

Lectures (interpretation of theory), demonstration forms (samples of interpreted subject matter at concrete examples, samples of subjects), teamwork (dialogues, situational games), self-study, individual study.


TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT, TEACHING AIDS

Modern air-conditioned classrooms in the city centre. Work desks, PCs, overhead projectors, screens, VCR, study texts in print, CD, online, data projector.

FINAL ASSESSMENT – final test (with a success rate above 60%) and controlled interview.
