In Bratislava on January 21, 2021 No. 1/2021-PR

In relation to the restriction of movement and accommodation due to a lockdown based on the Resolution of the Government of the Slovak Republic No. 808 of December 31, 2020 published in the Collection of Laws of the Slovak Republic under No. 453/2020 Coll. (hereinafter referred to as the "Government Resolution"), Resolution of the Government of the Slovak Republic No. 30 from January 17, 2021, published in the Collection of Laws of the Slovak Republic under No. 8/2021 Coll. and Resolution of the Government of the Slovak Republic No. 44 from January 21, 2021, published in the Collection of Laws of the Slovak Republic under No. 14/2021 Coll., and in accordance with Article 10 (3) of Rector's Directive No. 4/2013 - SR "Rules for Issuing Internal Regulations of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava" of October 3, 2013, the Rector of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava (hereinafter referred to as "STU")

is issuing

the following

of the Rector's Order No. 1/2021-PR
Anti-epidemic measures of the Slovak University of
Technology in Bratislava in relation to currently valid
measures of State institutions in SR
as amended by Amendment No. 1 from January 21, 2021

that the following measures be adopted with the aim of preventing COVID-19 from spreading:

Article 1

Organisation of and conditions applicable to the educational process

1) Conduct all educational activities at all levels of studies using the distance method as referred to in § 108e (2) of Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher education institutions, as amended.

Responsible persons: Deans of faculties, Director of the Institute of

Management of STU.

2) During the period of validity of the measure as referred to in Article 1 (1) above, the provisions of Article 1 (1) and (2) of Rector's Order No. 7/2020 – PR "Organisation of and conditions applicable to the educational process and operation of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava for the Winter term of the academic year 2020/2021" of September 29, 2020, as amended by Amendment 1 of November 26, 2020, and Amendment No.2 from January 13, 2021, shall not be applied temporarily.

Article 2 Organisation of work

- 1) Employees responsible for execution of the present Order are obliged to:
 - a) agree with employees on home office conditions in accordance with § 250b (2) of Act No. 311/2001 Coll. the Labour Code, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Labour Code"), in justified cases, if the agreed type of work enables it and if there are no material operational reasons on the part of the particular section of STU that would make it impossible to work from home. Managers at individual levels of management are obliged to check performance of work from home or, in justified cases, they shall
 - b) agree with an employee on provision of time off from work as referred to in § 142 and § 143 of the Labour Code; or
 - c) order collective drawing of paid holiday as referred to in § 111 of the Labour Code.

- 2) Measures as referred to in Article 2 (1) shall not apply to employees:
 - a) working on shifts and ensuring continuous operation;
 - b) performing tasks with statutory deadlines;
 - c) conducting urgent experimental activities in laboratories;
 - d) whose presence at the workplace is necessary according to a decision of persons responsible for execution of the present Rector's Order.
- 3) Employees according to (2) of this Article which enter the workplace from January 27, 2021 to February 02, 2021, must show the following:
 - a) a negative RT-PCR test result performed from January 18, 2021, or
 - b) a negative antigen test result certified in the territory of the European Union for COVID-19, performed from January 18, 2021
 - c) proof of overcoming COVID-19 no older than three months.
- 4) The provisions of Rector's Order No. 9/2020 PR "Measures aimed at preventing



communicable diseases from spreading at university workplaces and special purpose facilities under the responsibility of the Rector of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava" of December 21, 2020 are binding for all university workplaces and special purpose facilities under the managerial responsibility of the Rector.

Article 3 Accommodation in STU accommodation facilities

1) Due to restriction of the freedom of movement, travelling between districts lockdown, all students who were not staying at STU accommodation facilities under the responsibility of the Student Houses and Canteens of STU's special purpose facility (hereinafter referred to as "accommodation facility") on January 1, 2021 are not allowed to return to the accommodation facility until February 7, 2021.

Responsible person: Director of the Student Houses and Canteens of STU's special purpose facility

- 2) Students staying at the accommodation facility on January 1, 2021 may spend the lockdown period (January 1 24, 2021) in the particular accommodation facility, providing that they respect the conditions laid down in the Government Resolutions and in internal regulations of student houses.
- 3) The provisions of the present article shall not apply to:
 - (1) employees of STU staying at accommodation facilities,
 - (2) members of collective authorities of STU staying at accommodation facilities,
 - (3) guests staying at accommodation facilities at January 01, 2021.
- 4) Details regarding performance of provisions of the present Article shall be specified by the Director of the Student Houses and Canteens of STU's special purpose facility.

5) Measures related to any of STU's accommodation facilities outside the competence of the Student Houses and Canteens of STU's special purpose facility may be ordered, in accordance with the provisions of the present Rector's Order, by the dean of the faculty responsible for the particular accommodation facility.

Responsible person: **Dean of the relevant faculty**.



Article 4 Final provisions

- 1) This Rector's Order has been issued in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- 2) Individual persons responsible for performance of measures hereunder shall be authorized to specify details related to their performance.
- 3) Managers at individual levels of management are obliged to make their subordinate employees familiar with the content of the present Order immediately and to ensure its execution.
- 4) This Rector's Order may only be amended by numbered amendments signed by the Rector.
- 5) This Rector's Order shall come into effect on the date when it is issued.
- 6) Amendment No. 1 shall become valid on the day of its issuance, January 21, 2021.
