

Agreement on the establishment of an interest association of legal entities

conclude this agreement on the establishment of an interest association of legal entities called **European Nuclear Experimental Educational Platform.**

Article I

The name of the association is: European Nuclear Experimental Educational Platform (Hereinafter referred to as ENEEP Association, or association).

Article II

The registered seat of the association is: Ilkovičova 2961/3, 841 04 Bratislava – city district Karlova Ves, Slovakia.

Article III

Legal form: association of legal entities established pursuant to § 20f et seq. of Act no. 40/1964 Coll. of the Civil Code of the Slovak Republic as amended.

Article IV

1. The contracting parties/ founding Members of ENEEP Association establish the association for their common activities. In such matter the ENEEP Association:
 - 1.1. Offers access to nuclear experimental facilities and laboratories, for the performance
 - a. of experimental nuclear education and hands-on activities for students at all academic levels (bachelor, master and PhD),
 - b. of experimental nuclear training and hands-on activities for professionals,
 - c. of R&D activities in the field of nuclear engineering,
 - d. to persons designated by the Members of the ENEEP Association (hereinafter referred to as Members in a plural or as Member in singular) who are interested in education, training and research in nuclear engineering.
 - 1.2. Represents the interests of the Members of the ENEEP Association in communication with
 - a. international organizations, such as IAEA, ENEN, NEA, etc.
 - b. European funding organizations,
 - c. national public or governmental organizations,
 - d. nuclear industry,
 - e. other research organisations.
 - 1.3. Ensures the proper performance of the activities of its Members, its high professional and ethical level.
 - 1.4. Helps to resolve disputes amicably between the Members of the ENEEP Association.
 - 1.5. Informs the professional and lay public about its activities and provides basic information about its Members.
 - 1.6. To meet its purpose, the ENEEP Association has to:
 - a. ensure a high level of quality and relevance of nuclear education and training activities,
 - b. work towards increasing the attractiveness of the nuclear education and training activities and maintaining them up-to-date with scientific progress,
 - c. actively promote the nuclear education and training activities offered to potential users in Europe and abroad through various communication channels,
 - d. establish synergies with European Union initiatives in relevant nuclear disciplines,
 - e. cooperate with international and national governmental institutions, agencies and universities.
 - 1.7. The ENEEP Association carry out business activities as follow:
 - a. Adman, promotional activities and advertising,
 - b. Organization of scientific and professional seminars, conferences, courses, exhibitions, congresses in the scope of free trade,
 - c. Publishing activities in the scope of free trade,
 - d. Research and experimental development on natural sciences and engineering,
 - e. Organizing cultural and social events.

Article V

1. The contracting parties/ founding Members of ENEEP Association have concluded Statutes of this association, which form an annex to this agreement and further regulate the mutual rights and obligations of the Members of this association and its bodies.

Article VI

1. On behalf of the association, is entitled to act its statutory body, which is the President of the ENEEP Association.

Article VIII

1. This Agreement may be amended by written amendments signed by all the Contracting Parties.
2. Relations between the contracting parties that are not regulated by this agreement and the statutes of the association are governed by the Civil Code and other general binding legal regulations.
3. Any dispute that may arise shall be settled in mutual Agreement of concerned Members. In case a dispute is not settled out all and any disputes, discrepancies or claims arising out of or in connection with this agreement or in their context shall be resolved by the relevant court in Slovak republic. The Members of the ENEEP Association choose the jurisdiction and competence of the relevant courts of the Slovak Republic.
4. The governing law of this Agreement shall be the Slovak law.
5. If any provision of this agreement becomes invalid or unenforceable, it will not affect the validity or enforceability of the other provisions of the agreement. In such a case, the parties have undertaken to replace the invalid or unenforceable provisions with valid and enforceable provisions which will have the closest legal significance and effect as the provisions to be replaced. In the absence of any provision in the agreement that would otherwise be appropriate to the completeness of the regulation of rights and obligations, the Members shall make every effort to add such a provision to the agreement.
6. The agreement is made in 6 copies, of which each party will receive 1 copy (its origin), two copies will be submitted as an annex to the proposal for registration of the association.
7. The Contracting parties have understood the content of the agreement, declare that it has been concluded according to their legal and free will and sign it by hand as a sign of consent to its content.
