Methodological guidelines related to the possibility of the rechecking-in of doctoral degree students at accommodation facilities of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava

In accordance with Article 4 (2) of the Statute of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava (hereinafter referred to as "STU"), with regard to the extraordinary situation caused by the global Covid-19 pandemic, the related closure of STU's accommodation facilities in the competence of STU's Student Accommodation and Canteens special purpose facility on the basis of Rector's Order No 2/2019-PR "Extraordinary measures for preventing communicable diseases from spreading at accommodation facilities of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava" of March 11, 2020 and the effort of the Slovak Government to gradually loosen the crisis measures, I am issuing the following binding

methodological guidelines:

- 1. Effective from May 4, 2020, STU's doctoral degree students are allowed to stay at STU's accommodation facilities in the competence of STU's Student Accommodation and Canteens special purpose facility (hereinafter referred to as "recheck-in").
- 2. Recheck-in shall be performed under strict epidemiological measures adopted by STU's Student Accommodation and Canteens special purpose facility with regard to the current stage of the loosening of the crisis measures.
- 3. Recheck-in shall be performed on working days from 11.00 a.m.
- 4. Recheck-in shall be provided under the same contractual terms as before the accommodation facilities were closed. If any STU doctoral degree student checked out before the present methodological guidelines were issued, he/she has the possibility to return to his/her original room after he/she has been rechecked-in. This shall be without prejudice to the provisions of Rector's Order No 4/2020 PR "Early checkout from student residences of the Slovak University of Technology in Bratislava" of April 9, 2020.

5. Decisions about recheck-ins at STU's accommodation facilities outside the competence of STU's Student Accommodation and Canteens special purpose facility are the responsibility of the dean of the faculty who is responsible for the particular accommodation facility.
