**TRAINEESHIP
IN SARDINIA**



What is it?

The "Erasmus Traineeship in Sardinia" (ETS) is targeted at university students who wish to carry out a traineeship in a company, institution, private office, research center or agency of North Sardinia. The programme results from the cooperation between the University of Sassari, the Provincial Authority, the Municipality of Sassari and the Chamber of Commerce.

Who can apply?

Students enrolled in any university may apply and choose among over 150 traineeship positions.

In which professional fields are the traineeships available?

Agriculture, Forestry, Environmental Sciences, Urban and Landscape Planning, Architecture, Physics, Chemistry and Pharmacy, Biotechnology, Tourism, Economics, Marketing, Medicine, Health, Law, Public Administration, Political Sciences, Communication and Information, Humanities and Social Sciences, Archaeological Excavation, Linguistic Mediation, Library and Archival Sciences, Management and preservation of Nature reserves, Veterinary Medicine.

Facilitations and services

Selected students will be enrolled at the University of Sassari. They may attend courses and take exams, if compatible with the main training activity. Trainees will also benefit from: free courses of Italian language and culture organised by the University Language Centre; free access to library facilities and wireless connection; canteen at reduced fee; discounts on local public transports; free medical assistance; access to guidance and counseling service; discounts on music and theater tickets and sport activities.

A first reception service and a programme of leisure activities is also offered by the Erasmus Student Network (ESN) association.

Cils – Certification of Italian as a foreign language

Students who study Italian and need an official certification of their language proficiency have the opportunity to take the CILS examination at the Language Centre of the University of Sassari. CILS is the official certification to prove the communicative competence in the Italian language.
