Information regarding the extent of processing of personal data and about the rights of data subjects

Purpose of personal data processing:

Provision of accommodation

The legal basis of personal data processing in accordance of Article 6, item 1 b) of the Regulation and in accordance with Section 13, paragraph 1 b) of the Act – personal data processing is necessary to meet the obligations under the accommodation contract.

Recipients: None exists.

The collector does not intend to transfer the personal data into a third country or to an international organisation.

<u>Personal data retention period</u>: in the sense of the Records Retention Regulations of the STU.

The accommodated person, as a data subject, has, in the extent set out by the Regulation and the Act, the right to demand from the landlord access to personal data related to his or her person, the right to rectification of personal data, the right to restriction of personal data

processing, the right to object to the personal data processing, and the right to personal data portability.

In the event that the data subject thinks that his or her rights have been violated during the personal data processing or the Regulation or the Act have been breached, the data subject is entitled to file a request with the Personal Data Protection Office of the Slovak Republic to initiate proceedings regarding personal data protection.

The provision of the accommodated person's personal data is a requirement for entering into the accommodation contract; in the event of the accommodated person's failure to provide personal data, the accommodation contract could not be entered into and the obligations thereunder could not be met.

The personal data are not subject to automated individual decision-making, including profiling.
