

Admission requirements for applicants from Ukraine to the Institute of Management of the SUT in Bratislava

Admission of applicants – high school graduates for bachelor's studies, even if they do not have the necessary documents submitted during enrolment - i.e., especially a high school diploma/proof of obtaining a complete secondary education.

- 1 The essential condition for admission to bachelor's studies is acquiring a complete secondary education or a full secondary vocational education.
- 2 In the case of persons who have been granted asylum, subsidiary protection or temporary refuge status, the condition referred to in paragraph 1 may be proved by a statutory declaration and a test of general educational qualifications.

It applies particularly to applicants who have completed upper secondary education in previous years and do not have evidence of completion.

In the case of applicants who will graduate this school year and for objective reasons, they will not be able to submit documents proving the fulfilment of the essential condition for admission to the bachelor's degree (no graduation documents will be issued), no later than on the day designated for enrolment, they will submit a solemn declaration and proof of completion of the test of general study prerequisites.
